- Please ensure that you bring your entry form and money on either Monday 15th or Monday 22nd August to the Corsley Reading Room: 7 - 8.30 pm or post to arrive by 24th August to:

- Please ensure that entry fees are paid before 9 am on Show Day.
- Do not bring exhibits to registration in the Corsley Reading Room. Exhibits can only be accepted at the marquee on Sunday 28th August 2 - 7 pm or on Show Day 6.45 - 9 am.
- Entry to the marquee will be closed at 9 am on Show Day – please do not be late with your entries!! The marquee will be cleared of exhibitors at 9 am prompt for judging to take place.
- Previous experience has shown that the high humidity of the marquee can cause severe deterioration of paper and card-based exhibits, particularly photographs, if left overnight. Fragile exhibits should be brought to the marquee on Show Day. The committee regrets it cannot accept responsibility for loss of, or damage to, exhibits.
- Exhibitors in the Handicrafts Division are responsible for providing their own hanging/display materials.
- Please ensure that all jams, jellies, marmalades and chutneys are labelled and dated where appropriate.
- Under Health & Safety rules all food items must be covered.
- Please place all exhibitor cards face down so that the exhibitor numbers are not visible to the judges.
- The Committee strongly encourages anonymous explanatory notes to accompany exhibits. For example, to name the variety of fruit, vegetable or flower entries or to explain stitches, metalwork or woodworking techniques or other features in a craft item or ingredients in a homecraft item. Please make the notes no bigger than A5.
