## Ring 1 Commencing 9 am prompt

### SHOW JUMPING

Entry fee £5

Prizes £8, £6, £4

Special rosette awarded for the best local competitor in each class

- 1 **65cm Novice Jumping.** Open to combinations never to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any jumping competition. Max height 65cm (2ft 3ins) in first round.  
*Winner receives Benalfa Shield.*  
*Best local competitor W P R Sandoe Challenge Cup.*
- 2 **75cm Open Jumping.** 75cm (2ft 6ins) in first round.  
*Highest placed rider 12 years and under receives The Riding Shop Challenge Cup.*  
*Best local competitor receives the Mole Valley Plate.*
- 3 **Horse and Hound.** Max Height 80cm (2ft 6ins) for the horses (lower for the dogs!) combinations of horse and hound with riders and runners to jump two timed courses. *See rule 15 for this class.*  
*Winner receives the Zebedee Cup.*  
*Special prize for the best local combinations.*
- 4 **85cm Open Jumping.** 85cm (2ft 9ins) in first round.  
*Highest placed rider 14 years and under receives the Hardings Ground Trophy.*  
*Best local competitor receives the Munro Plate.*
- 5 **The Chase me Charlie.** Open to all.  
*Winner to receive the Merkin Cup.*
- 6 **90cm-1m Open.** Max height 1m (3ft 3ins) in first round.  
*Winner receives The G A Bayman Trophy.*  
*Best local competitor receives the L V Fitzpatrick Cup.*

### BEST TURNOUT AND RIDING HORSES

Special rosette awarded for the best local competitor in each class

- 7 **Best Ridden Turnout.**  
*Highest placed rider 14 years and under receives the Sleeman-Hiscock Trophy.*  
*Highest placed rider 15 years and over to receive the Vincents Trophy.*
- 8 **Riding Horse – 15hh and over.**  
*Winner receives the W Hoskins Challenge Cup.*  
*Will not be required to jump. May be ridden by the judge.*  
*Owner of the best shod horse in this class will receive the “Cornishfaer” Trophy.*

- 9 **Best Riding Cob.** Open to all. Class may be split '14.2 and under' '14.2 and over'. Winner receives the John Jackson Cup.  
*May be ridden by judge.*
- 10 **Fancy Dress.**  
Winner receives the Chatfield Rose Bowl.  
Rosettes to all competitors.  
*NB Competitors must wear current safety standard hard hats if mounted.*

**WORKING HUNTERS AND PONIES**

Special rosette awarded for the best local competitor in each class

- 11 **Open Working Hunter.** Horses over 14.2hh. Max height of jumps 85cm (2ft 9ins).  
Winner receives the Harris and Hill Challenge Cup.  
*May be ridden by Judge.*
- 12 **Working Pony.** Ponies 14.2hh and under. Max height of jumps 65cm (2ft 3ins).  
Winner receives the Longhedge Cup.
- 13 **Working Championships.**  
*For 1st and 2nd prizewinners in Classes 11 and 12 for the V C Boulton Challenge Cup.*

**HORSE AND PONY SPECIAL CLASS**

Special rosette awarded for the best local competitor in each class

- 14 **Leading Rein Pony Rider 7 years and under.** Most suitable lead rein pony judged on manners not conformation.  
Winner receives the W J Jones Challenge cup.  
*Rosettes for all competitors.*
- 15 **First Ridden Pony.** Riders 10 years and under. NOT to be led. Most suitable first ridden pony judged on manners and not conformation.  
Winner receives the Henry Edwards Memorial Cup.
- 16 **Family Horse/Pony.** Suitable for any member of the family to ride 13hh to 16hh.  
May be asked to jump, do a show.  
Winner receives the James Guy Memorial Trophy.  
*Highest placed M&M receives the Coates & Parker Challenge cup.  
Highest placed coloured receives the Scrabble Cup.*
- 17 **Veterans.** For horses and ponies 15 years old or over. May be led or ridden. Class may be split.  
Winner receives the Mrs V Bowmaster Memorial Cup.  
*Rosettes for all competitors  
Please note that proof of age may be asked for.*

- 18 **Ex-Racehorse.** Open to horses that have been re-trained to take part in another equestrian activity. To be eligible horses must have been in training and raced under rules.

*Winner to receive the Tinker's Cuss Trophy.*

**DRESSAGE**

Entries for Class 19 may be restricted and should be pre-entered

- 19 **Percentage Dressage**, to be judged as one class. Riders may choose from Prelim 1 2006, Prelim 18 2002 or British Dressage Introductory A (a walk and trot test). Maximum of three tests per rider.

*Winner receives the Leslie Firman-Ford Memorial Plate.*

*Highest placed rider under 16 receives the 'Vall Carlos' Trophy.*

*Rosettes to 6th place in each class.*

*The Cross Keys Trophy will be awarded to the highest percentage by a local rider.*

**CLEAR ROUND JUMPING**

Clear round jumping will commence again after Class 22 if time permits

Entries on the field – entry fee £3.00

Rosettes for all clear rounds

Height of the fences will be raised during the morning. All riders must be suitably dressed for the ring and all riders must have a number to enter this class. Numbers are available at Secretary's Tent at a cost of £2 towards First Aid Cover.

**HANDY PONY AND MINI JUMPING**

Prizes £5, £4, £3

Special rosette awarded for the best local competitor in each class

- 20 **Handy Pony.** Pony and rider will be required to negotiate an obstacle course. Riders 10 years and under.

- 21 **Minimus Jumping.** Riders 8 years and under (must be led).

*Winner to receive the Longleat Estate Trophy.*

- 22 **Mini Jumping.** Riders 10 years and under. May NOT be led and must NOT have entered Class 20.

*Winner receives the Chard Trophy.*

- 23 **Mini Pairs Jumping.** Riders 10 years and under. Two riders and two ponies to jump two timed rounds with their combined scores and times to count.

*Winners receive the Val Sandoe Challenge Cups (a cup for each rider).*
