CLASSIC AND VINTAGE VEHICLES

**Classic and vintage cars, tractors, commercial vehicles,
motorcycles, military vehicles and stationary engines**

Conditions applicable to exhibitors

- Exhibitors are requested to arrive between 8.30 am and 10 am to set up their exhibit. Late-comers may be delayed or refused entry, depending on circumstances. Exhibit exits and re-entry are not allowed and we would expect the exhibit to remain in place to at least 4 pm or until any contrary announcement is made. A parade of vehicles will take place in the main arena mid-afternoon.
- The speed limit is 5 mph within the Showground at all times.
- All vehicles must have a current MOT certificate where applicable.
- All drivers must have a full current driving licence for the class of vehicle.
- All vehicles must have current Third Party Insurance covering all road risks.
- All stationary engines should have Public Liability Insurance for a minimum of £2,000,000
- All certificates to be available for Inspection on the day.
- Exhibitors agree to comply with the safety procedures advised to them by Show Officials and to use signposted entry and exit routes to the display area.
- Exhibitors understand that the Corsley Show Ltd/ Society Committee, members and officials can accept no liability for loss or damage to vehicles, property or exhibits or for personal injury whilst on the Showground. The exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any damage, injury or loss arising from any article property or exhibit brought onto the Showground by them and they do indemnify the Corsley Show Ltd/Society, Committee, Members and officers as being blameless, In any actions or claims occasioned by the exhibitor the exhibit or any helpers that effect any third parties.
- Check your home insurance provides damage cover and cover for your actions, whilst following a personal pursuit and for any other display equipment.
- No fuel should be carried on the vehicle other than that which is in the vehicle's tank.
- No live flame within the vehicle area. Vehicles must carry modern fire extinguishers.
- Every vehicle should have its engine switched off and ignition keys removed. It should be left in a safe state with the handbrake on and chocked if necessary.
- Vehicles not road registered may be brought to the Showground on a trailer but must not be offloaded onto the Showground unless a full Third Party Insurance & Public Liability Insurance for a minimum of £2,000,000 is also covering the exhibit. Certificates to be available for Inspection on the day.
- Using any other display equipment e.g. banners, flag poles, gazebo, picture display boards or any ancillary display of artefacts around the vehicle? For all such personal equipment and artefact collections and ancillaries to any display, home insurance should be able to provide damage cover and cover for your actions, whilst following a personal pursuit. This would also be covered under the Personal Public Liability section of your home insurance policy. You should check the cover provided by your policy and with your insurers to assure in the event of any claim you have the appropriate cover.
